This post will lead and coordinate the Secretariat's Asia Division ( Six permanent staff based in Tokyo, one in Manila and a team of around thirty staff co-ordinated by a Programme Manager from Hanoi, Vietnam to specifically run the Indochina programme) in supporting the regional network of 13 conservation organizations to deliver the agreed regional BirdLife programme. This post will appeal to a motivated, enthusiastic individual with considerable conservation, management, networking and fundraising success.

Reporting to the Director of Network and Programme, you will work closely with the Management Team and Senior Staff from other regional Divisions and the headquarters in Cambridge (UK). Considerable international travel within Asia will be necessary.
